

Curriculum Overview for Year 2/3 –Yew Tree class: Autumn 1

English:

Reading - Building upon our love of reading and extending our reading skills to find answers within a text.

Grammar and punctuation - Securing our phonetic knowledge (Year 2) and recapping on the skills we have learnt previously

For effective sentence structure (Year 2 and 3).

Spelling - Introducing new spelling rules for Year 3 and Year 2 required for Autumn term.

Book focus 1: Captain Yellowbelly - A great story about a captain who has the worst luck but it all turns out ok in the end!

Book focus 2: Could a Penguin ride a bike? Focussing on question writing and using facts to build explanations in a fun way.

Art and Design:

Linked to DT – Chagford Sketchwork.

Computing:

E-Safety and using the tablets/internet responsibly.

Creating booklets on Chagford.

Maths:

Some of the areas we will be covering this half-term...

Number Sense – Securing our understanding of place value and comparing and recognising numbers up to 100 (Year 2) and 1000 (Year 3) through different games, activities and scenarios.

Year 2 – Numbers up to 100. Year 3 – Numbers beyond 100 and up to 1000.

Additive Reasoning – Building upon what we have learnt previously before extending onto applying our skills with higher numbers (100's and 1000's) - Year 3.

Introducing new ways of adding different amounts together with amounts up to 100 - Year 2.

Design and Technology:

Re-creating Chagford buildings and features with 3D CAD and Papier Mache.

Geography:

Exploring our local area and creating our own maps of Chagford.

Modern Languages

Not required at KS1.
